A Sweet Afternoon of Ice Cream

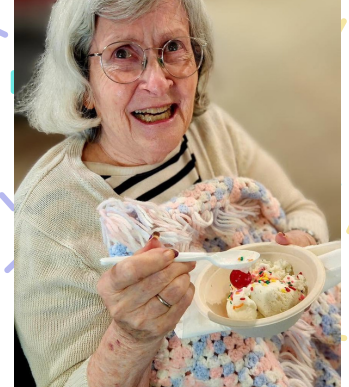
